FAST FACTS

- 11,000+ churches planted since 2010
- 11% of all SBC churches are Send Network churches
- 18% of all SBC baptisms are from churches planted since 2010
- 1,360+ Hispanic churches planted from 2011-2021
- 790+ African American SBC churches planted from 2011-2021
- An average 55%+ of SBC church plants are minority ethnic or multi-ethnic



FAST FACTS

- Around 3.4 million people in San Diego County, which is a diverse, global city
- Around 12% claim Evangelical Christianity, but only about half of those (around 6% of total population)
 are even loosely connected with an Evangelical local church. Reaching 1% is around 27,125 people.
- 55 viable church plants that have been planted over the last 12 years (about 30% of total SBC churches in SD County)
- Combined average attendance of those churches is 5,000+ people
- In 2024, counting only churches in their first 5 years, there were over 200 baptisms
- We currently plant between 6 10 churches with a strong viability rate most years, but to keep up with population growth and to reach the 1% we need to plant up to 3 times that (20-30 each year).






CHALLENGES TO CHURCH PLANTING

- Spiritual Warfare
- Post/Pre-Christian Culture
- Internal Obstacles in churches that try to keep us unengaged in God's Mission. This can include weak churches seeing few people come to Christ. These churches may feel isolated, become internally focused, and settle for survival and self-preservation.
- San Diego is one of the most expensive cities in the US, especially when considering the cost of housing.
- Transient population leads to high turnover in church attendees, especially in urban locations









AMAZING OPPORTUNITIES

- Global City more than 100 languages spoken in San Diego County, and we are a gateway to many nations as an international port and land border crossing city.
- Dense Population of Gospel Need Over 3 million people are not connected to to an Evangelical, Gospel centered church. There are almost 2 million people in Tijuana right on our southern border.
- College students & Military There are almost 250,000 college students in San Diego County. There are 250,000 active duty military, and over 400,000 when including military contractors.
- Global influence through tech companies (Apple, Qualcomm, Sony, etc.), bio-tech companies, athletes/ cultural influencers/entertainers, tourism, and more.
- San Diego sends much content and ideas throughout the world, and our prayer is that we would also send the Gospel as well.

- We want to collaborate, partner, and innovate to reach COLLEGE STUDENTS, MILITARY FAMILIES, and COMMUNITIES in need of Jesus and Gospel centered churches.
